Sunday, 4 November 2012

On arrival at Port Elizabeth Airport, collect your Group E car hire vehicle (Toyota Corolla or similar) from Avis and make your way to Kariega Game Reserve for check in at Main Lodge.

Kariega Game Reserve Main Lodge

A natural extension to the Garden Route, just 80 minutes from Port Elizabeth, this malaria-free Big 5 private game reserve, incorporates contrasting riverine, bushveld and grassland eco-systems and is bordered by the picturesque Bushmans and Kariega Rivers. In addition to superb morning and evening game viewing from open vehicles with experienced Game Rangers, Kariega is unique in its offering of safe walking close to abundant game and birdlife and a diversity of activities which include river cruises on the popular "Kariega Queen", canoeing, mountain biking, swimming in beautiful river pools and visits to the nearby golden beaches of Kenton-on-Sea for bathing, a stroll or horse riding. Kariega prides itself in the abundance of general game and birdlife supplementing the Big 5. Wonderful sightings of lion, elephant, rhino, hippo, giraffe, zebra and numerous antelope species can be enjoyed in addition to resident Martial, Crowned and Fish Eagles. Kariega Lodge comprises spacious and comfortable log chalets, all bedrooms en-suite with private viewing decks and some with private pools. Fine traditional meals are provided in the Architectural Award-winning restaurant or boma, which expertly integrates with nature and the environment and radiates an informal, friendly and relaxed atmosphere. Ukhozi Lodge ("the place of Eagles") accommodates 20 guests in 10 superbly appointed luxury suites crafted from log, with panoramic views from private decks. The Lodge boasts unique African-style lounges, restaurant and boma with an outdoor heated pool. Here, guests can unwind in front of log fires, enjoy sumptuous cuisine or simply share an experience of the African bush.

Thoughtful service, laid back comfort, and the opportunity to test your mettle on the best links course I have ever designed is all part of the St Francis Lodge experience. Guests can expect to leave this luxurious choice of accommodation with a replenished spirit and renewed love of the game. A divine combination of elegant African style and luxury awaits the visitor. The lodge consists of two separate serviced houses, each with 5 luxuriously appointed en-suite bedrooms and several relaxed living areas that take in the sweeping views of the golf course, ocean, and the gentle waterways of the surrounding riverside thatched village. Relax in our 10 bedrooms of which 8 are golf-course facing and have beautiful double showers. The other 2 rooms have both bath and shower as well as an outside shower on the enclosed patio. Feast on a scrumptious homemade breakfast on the verandah before teeing off and enjoy the luxurious facilities at The Links Club House. Montagu, named after the Montagu pass was originally designed by Gary Player and is a much celebrated parkland course and has been ranked as the number-one golf course in South Africa in the past and is currently ranked as No. 7 (Golf Digest Rankings 2011). The exquisitely conditioned Montagu is at the heart of Fancourt, with its glorious parkland layout, covering large tracts of varying terrain on rolling land. It's beauty is enhanced by mature trees, flower beds, shrubs and water hazards that provide a colourful contrast to the landscape. The warm-up area, featuring a full-length range and a chipping and bunker practice area, is available to all golfers before play. Golf carts are available for hire, weather permitting.

Outeniqua, named after the mountain range that overlooks the area has a different look than the Montagu, so they complement each other perfectly as varying playing experiences. The Outeniqua is regarded as the easier course of the two, being more open in appearance, yet it has its share of challenges and risk-and-reward moments. Water hazards or streams come into play on as many as 11 of the holes, including 4 of the last 5. The warm-up area, featuring a full-length range and a chipping and bunker practice area, is available to all golfers before play. Golf carts are available for hire, weather permitting.
